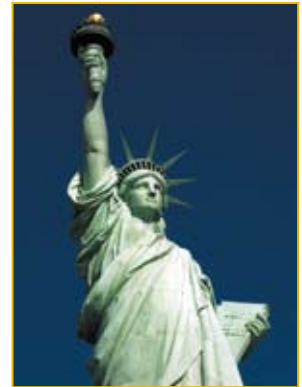




We've stuck to our flight plan for 10 years Continental celebrates 10 years flying from Ireland to the U.S.
