## EMBASSY OF THE UNITED STATES DUBLIN-IRELAND ESTA DENIAL – WHAT TO DO NEXT



The **Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA)** is a program run by the Department of Homeland Security's Bureau of Custom and Border Protection (CBP). **The U.S. Embassy does not administer the ESTA program and has no authority to review ESTA applications.** If you have been Denied ESTA at the Port of Entry, please follow the below steps to apply for a Visa.

If your **ESTA** application was denied and you would like travel to the United States, you will be required to apply for a **non-immigrant visa** at a U.S. Embassy or Consulate. If you are not resident in Ireland, please consider returning to your country of residence to apply.

All visa interviews are by appointment only. <u>Please do not come to the Embassy until you have followed the steps below.</u> The Visa Unit will interview and process only those who have completed the application process and scheduled a visa interview.

- **Apply for a nonimmigrant visa:** Please visit our website <a href="https://ie.usembassy.gov/visas/nonimmigrant-visas/">https://ie.usembassy.gov/visas/nonimmigrant-visas/</a> to fill out a DS-160 visa application
- **Schedule Visa Appointment:** All visa appointments must be made through the CSC Visa Appointment Service either by phone or on-line. Applicants should log on to <a href="http://usvisa-info.com">http://usvisa-info.com</a> and follow the online instructions carefully.
- **Request Expedited Appointment:** Please take the first available appointment, then you may request an expedited appointment through the same online scheduling system. A consular officer will review your expedite request and reschedule your interview <u>if you qualify for an expedited interview.</u> The Visa Unit does not expedite interview appointments for non-emergency travel or if the reason for the ESTA denial is due to the individual's failure to complete the ESTA applications truthfully.

## **ESTA Denial Due to Travel to Certain Countries**

If your application has been denied due to prior travel to or nationality of Iran, Iraq, Syria, Sudan, Libya, Yemen, or Somalia **or** because your passport is not an E-Passport, please include this information in your expedite request. The Visa Unit will approve expedite requests for individuals affected by this recent change to Visa Waiver Program travel.
